Coastal Georgia Council Strip Design Contest

July 1 – August 30, 2017

For registered Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Venturers, and Leaders

For the 12th consecutive year, the Coastal Georgia Council will present a special council strip to individuals who support the 2018 Family Friends of Scouting program that helps fund local Scouting activities. The design of each year's special council strip is based on one of the points of the Scout Law. The theme for this design is ***A Scout is Reverent***.

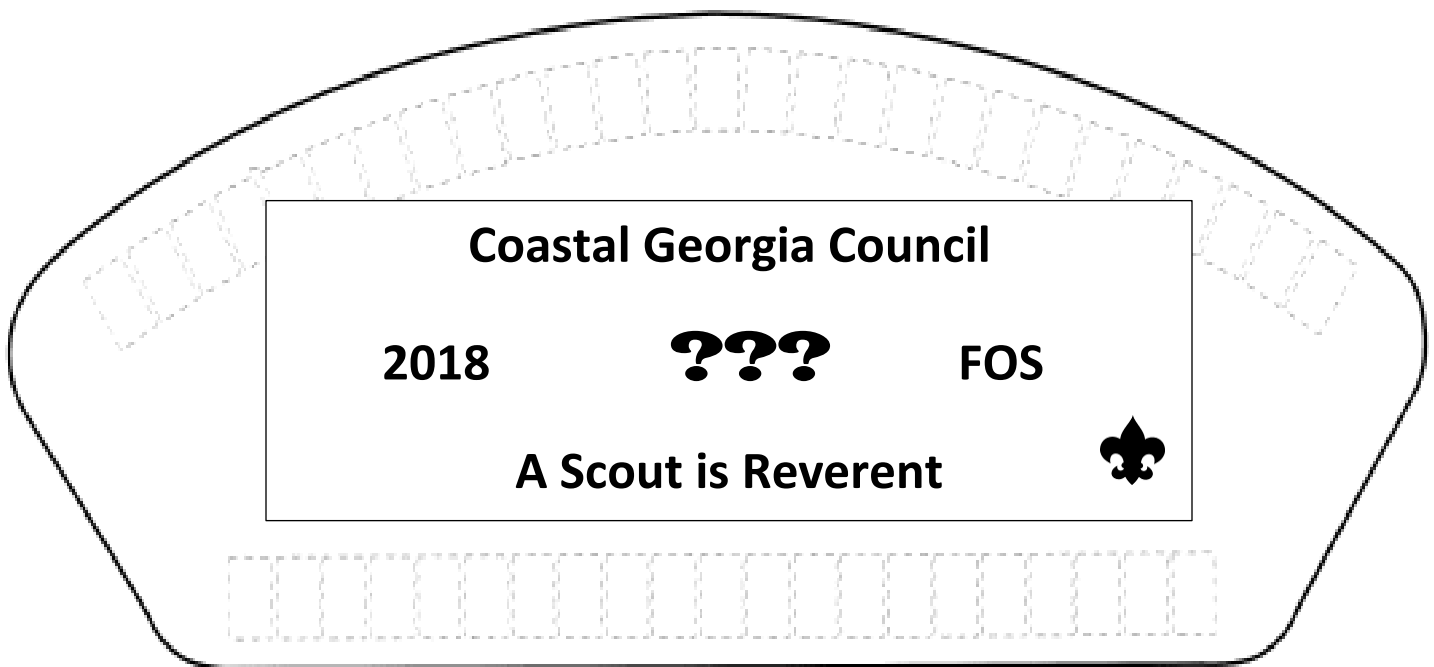
A patch has more significance when the design is the creative work of a Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Venturer, or leader; therefore, **a contest for the 2018 design begins on July 1 and ends at midnight on August 30.**

Contest Rules:

- 1. The design must be the creative work of a registered Cub Scout, Boy Scout or Venturer, or leader.**
- 2. The design must conform to the shape and size on the accompanying template.**
- 3. The design must depict the theme: *A Scout is Reverent*.**
- 4. The design must contain the following items: 1.) a fleur-de-lis, 2.) "FOS" 3.) "A Scout is Reverent" 4.) "2018" and 5.) "Coastal Georgia Council."**
- 5. Some element of the design must represent the local area (within the Coastal Georgia Council).**
- 6. The design must be in color.**
- 7. The name and age of the youth designer along with the pack, troop, or crew number must be provided or the name of the leader and his/her registered position.**
- 8. The design will become the property of the Coastal Georgia Council and may be modified for production purposes.**
- 9. The artwork must be submitted electronically via email to pmastopoulos@att.net by midnight on August 30, 2017.**
- 10. A committee will select the winning design. The winner of the contest will receive the first 2018 Friends of Scouting council strip on a plaque as a memento.**
