**When:** 13-14 September, 2019 (6 pm, Friday – 4 pm, Saturday)

**Cost:** \$15 per person. (Includes meals). Register on the Council website

**What:** Bring a tent, sleeping bag, sleeping pad, mess kit, eating utensils, water bottle, coffee mug, chair, hat, bug spray, sun block, note pad, pen, change of clothes, toiletries, flashlight/headlamp, pocket knife, snacks (if desired), and CLASS A UNIFORM or PACK T-SHIRT. (This will be an overnight event.)
